



1st Summer School

Satellites and Space Communications: Law, Policies and Technologies

Imperia Campus of Genoa University, 20-24 July 2015

The summer school on satellites and space communications is a **multi-disciplinary project** that aims at giving an **analysis of the current main legal and technical issues** related to the topic. To this end, CIELI is the promoter of a joint initiative involving the **Department of Law**, the Department of Electrical, Electronic and Telecommunications Engineering, and Naval Architecture (**DITEN**) of the University of Genoa.

The **venue** will be the town of Imperia, located on Italy's north-western coast, easily reachable via Genoa or Nice airports and home to a University campus where the event will take place from **20 July to 24 July 2015**.

The initiative aims to attract **doctoral and post doctoral** students, as well as **researchers and young professionals in law, political science and engineering**. Precisely the participation is opened to **students who have attended at least a three years' study university course** in the above-mentioned topics.

Students who will attend at least 75% of the lessons will be provided with an **attendance certificate** by the organisation. Moreover, within the programme a **Workshop** involving the active participation of students is forecast in order to stimulate their knowledge of the topic.

The **speakers** will be academics from the University of Genoa and other Italian Universities as well as operators in the field of space communications' industries and institutions.

The participation to the summer school **does not request the payment of a fee**, although the cost for the accommodation is totally upon the participants. **Registration** to the summer school however is needed, by sending an e-mail with a short motivation letter and a CV in attachment to cieli@unige.it before **June the 20th**. The **object** of the e-mail has to be *Summer School Satellites and Space Communications*.
